New looms for the Textile Room at PACC

Last term, we were delighted to acquire eight new 8-shaft Louet Jane table looms for the textile room. Thanks to the excellent application by committee member Frida Bleakley, we secured £1000 from the East Lothian Council Common Good Funds, with additional funding from PACC covering the remaining costs. Special thanks also go to The Threshing Barn, our chosen vendor, who provided exceptional service.

The looms can be set up with various weaves, offering greater complexity compared to our previous looms. This allows eight weavers to learn new techniques that were previously limited to one or two students at a time. Additionally, two wider looms were purchased, enabling members to weave large fabric pieces, such as blankets.

These modern looms have proven to be extremely userfriendly, especially when compared to the older looms. They can be folded and stored between classes, providing more table space for notes and creating a more comfortable learning environment.

Next term, beginner weavers will use some of these looms and benefit from their ease of use, hopefully encouraging continued learning and participation in weaving.

Photography Workshops—new this year!

Committee member and local photographer, Pete Harper, will host three brand new entry level/beginner photography workshops this year.
