#### Plein Air Workshop with Iona Molleson

On 17 May eight of our members joined plein air artist Iona Molleson for an Outdoor Painting Workshop near the River Tyne. The Workshop was a taste of the challenges and fun of setting off outdoors with your painting kit to observe and respond firsthand to the landscape and our environment. Iona started with a demonstration of the initial stages of her alla prima painting in oils, with a tonal underpainting in Burnt Sienna, then applying the vivid blue of the sky and interplay of purple shadows and sunlight in lively brushwork. Painters must work quickly and confidently to capture changing light and colours. Students found their painting spot, set up field easels and filled



their palettes with either acrylic or oil paint. Iona tutored and supported as their plein air paintings developed. For some it was their first time painting from observation outdoors. A short display and reflection of everyone's delightful alla prima paintings rounded off the workshop! Iona will be running another Plein Air Workshop from the Poldrate on Saturday 23 August 10am to 4pm.
